Finishing	Condition sheets come first, followed by rear cover and front cover. Ticket coupons to be stapled or glued to condition sheets. Front cover will be folded around.			
Packing	Delivered open, 1.000 covers per box, each one labelled with content. Boxes packed onto pallet, shrink wrapped with polyethylene foil.			
Notes	Cover is suitable for all kinds of tickets. ATB-2 need to be stapled to cover, carbonized tickets can also be glued. Selfadhesive strip on first condition sheet available on request.

Notice: If the passenger's journey involves an ultimate destination or stop in a country other than the country of departure the Warsaw Convention may be applicable and the Convention governs and in most cases limits the liability of carriers for death or personal injury and in respect of loss or damage to baggage. Conditions of Contract

- As used in this contract "ticket" means this passenger ticket and baggage check, or this itinerary/receipt if applicable, in the case of an electronic ticket, of which these conditions and the notices from part, "carriage" is equivalent to "transportation", "carrier" means all air carriers that carry or undertake to carry the passenger or his baggage hereunder or perform any other service incidental to such air carriage, "electronic ticket" means the Itinerary/Receipt issued by or on behalf of Carrier, the Electronic Coupons and, if applicable, a boarding document. "Warsaw Convention" means the Convention for the Unification of Certain Rules Relating to International Carriage by Air signed at Warsaw,
- 12th October 1929, or that Convention as amended at The Hague, 28th September 1955, whichever may be applicable.
- 2. Carriage hereunder is subject to the rules and limitations relating to liability established by the Warsaw Convention unless such carriage is not "international carriage" as defined by that Convention.**
- To the extent not in conflict with the foregoing carriage and other services performed by each carrier are subject to: (i) provisions contained in the ticket, (ii) applicable tariffs, (iii) carrier's conditions of carriage and related regulations which are made part hereof (and are available on application at the offices of carrier), except in transportation between a place in the United States or Canada and any place outside thereof to which tariffs in force in those countries apply.
- Carrier's name may be abbreviated in the ticket, the full name and its abbreviation being set forth in carrier's tariffs, conditions of carriage, regulations or timetables; carrier's address shall be the airport of departure shown opposite the first abbreviation of carrier's name in the ticket; the agreed stopping places are those places set forth in this ticket or as shown in carrier's timetables as scheduled stopping places on the passenger's route; carriage to be performed hereunder by several successive carriers is regarded as a single operation.
- An air carrier issuing a ticket for carriage over the lines of another air carrier does so only as its Agent.

6. Any exclusion to and be for representatives used by carrier representatives

7. Checked baggage check international transportation writing to carrier the latest, written complaint must be filed within 14 days of the date of the loss or damage to baggage. The carrier shall not be liable for loss of or damage to baggage if the carrier is not notified of the loss or damage to baggage within the time specified in the ticket or in the applicable tariffs, conditions of carriage, regulations or timetables.

8. This ticket is good for carriage for one year from date of issue, except as otherwise provided in this ticket, in carrier's tariffs, conditions of carriage, or related regulations. The fare for carriage hereunder is subject to change prior to commencement of carriage. Carrier may refuse transportation if the applicable fare has not been paid.

9. Carrier undertakes to use its best efforts to carry the passenger and baggage with reasonable dispatch.

10. Passenger shall comply with Government travel requirements, present exit, entry and other required documents and arrive at airport by time fixed by carrier or, if no time is fixed, early enough to complete departure procedures.

11. No agent, servant or representative of carrier has authority to alter, modify or waive any provision of this contract.

ADVICE TO INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS ON LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Additional protection can usually be obtained by purchasing the carrier's liability insurance. Please refer to your agent or the carrier's office for details.

NOTICE OF BAGGAGE LIABILITY LIMITATIONS

Liability for loss of or damage to baggage is limited to 1,000 SDR per passenger for each piece of baggage. The carrier shall not be liable for loss of or damage to baggage if the carrier is not notified of the loss or damage to baggage within the time specified in the ticket or in the applicable tariffs, conditions of carriage, regulations or timetables.

Lighter fuels, paints and thinner; matches and articles which are liable to spontaneous combustion, or which may emit flammable gases; inflammable solids; oxidizing substances; toxic substances; infectious substances; radioactive materials; and other dangerous goods are not permitted for carriage in baggage.
